



Pre-K Program Ages 4

Our Pre-K class prepares children for a smooth, successful start to kindergarten with a rich mix of hands-on learning, structured literacy, and district-aligned readiness goals. Staff post weekly lesson plans so families can follow learning at home. We use Handwriting Without Tears for progressive letter and number formation and partner with local school districts to meet Kindergarten expectations. A spring kindergarten readiness assessment ensures each child is on track.

Key features

- Hands-on, inquiry and STEM activities; curriculum centers; scheduled outside time
- Kindergarten readiness aligned with school district requirements
- Field trips and real-world exploration to extend classroom learning
- Social-emotional learning woven into daily routines
- Small class size with trained staff

Typical developmental skills

- Cognitive: retells stories; names people, objects, and places
- Movement: catches a large ball; practices pouring; develops correct pencil grip
- Social & Emotional: engages in pretend play; practices turn-taking; learns helpful routines
- Language: uses structured sentences; talks about daily experiences; answers questions clearly
